Parents...

You are the Primary educator of your children. Our Catechists and staff are only with your students 90 minutes a week. In order to bring the content started in class to life, you must be willing to take an active role in your own faith to lead your children by example through:

- Weekly Mass attendance:
- Reviewing your children's religious education folder at home each week
- Helping your child complete any RE assignments or projects
- Praying with your child and for your child at home as a family.
- Do their best to deliver and pick up your young person on time
- Assure your student has consistent appropriate behavior.

Students...

As the next generation of the faithful, we welcome students to a safe environment in which they can deepen their faith. To help make our time together positive meaningful, we ask all students to:

- Attend Mass on a regular basis with my family.
- Be punctual and prepared for class (this includes completing any assigned homework)
- Follow arrival and dismissal procedures given by the catechist.
- Show respect for themselves, catechists, other students and program personnel.
- Avoid bringing illegal substances, weapons, or anything that could cause someone harm to class.
- Turn off all gadgets (i.e. cell phones, tablets, etc.) during class, or leave home if able.
- Do not bring food, drinks, or gum in the classroom or church.
- Be courteous and considerate of others.
- Use language and actions expressive of Christian behavior.
- Obey safety rules at all times.
- Be present only in areas of the building for which they have permission.
- Be cooperative and participate in all sessions and activities to the best of their ability.
- Treat parish/school property and that of fellow students with respect.

In the case of unsatisfactory conduct, the catechist will speak with the student. If misconduct continues, the child will be sent to talk to the Director of RE. Should the student be unwilling to correct their conduct, the student's parents or guardian will be called in for a meeting. If the misconduct is serious, it may be the basis for removal from the program.

We have read and understand the above statements of conduct. We will do our best to abide by these rules and cooperate with them for my own benefit and the welfare of others.
